The Flying Dog Foundation Awards a \$2,100 Grant to MotorCity Greyhound Rescue for China-to-Canada Rescue Transport

Piscataway, NJ: The Flying Dog Foundation (TFDF), a 501(c)(3) registered charity in the United States of America helps make profoundly positive, life-saving changes in the lives of dogs in dire situations by awarding grants to partner rescue organizations. The primary focus is on, though not limited to, dogs rescued from the meat trade and hunting dogs in Spain. The Foundation is an all-volunteer registered charity in the USA. In January 2021, The Flying Dog Foundation (TFDF) awarded a \$2,000 grant to MotorCity Greyhound Rescue.
